# **Accessibility - Gran Via**

The Gran Via venue is fully accessible, thus guaranteeing the full participation of all attendees. The venue is free of obstacles and all its floors are accessible by lift.

#### Our venue

Fira Barcelona's Gran Via venue is totally accessible using wheelchair, power wheelchairs or scooters.

All floors and conference centers are reached through unobstructed access.

All our front desk counters are also adapted with one position at a height of 80cm.

#### Access

All parkings have special disabled reserved places.

Access from public transportation (Metro and FGC) is connected using lifts with automatic doors.

Equipment

### Lifts

Lift control panels are adapted to the height of wheelchair users and most of them have braile text. Every area can be reached by lifts, including all Conference Centers and Metro connection. The intercom facility is activated by the alarm button.

All corridors have a clear width of a minimum 1200mm.

Stairs are fitted with handrails to ensure the safety of senior users.

#### **Toilets**

All toilets in the venue have at least one cabin adapted for wheelchair use, with a minimum width of 1200mm, grab rails and low sink.

Museums adapted for the blind and partially sighted, hotels without barriers, accessible beaches and sign-language tours. Whether you're a visitor or looking for accessible ways to discover the city, we invite you to navigate Barcelona's wide choice of suggestions.





Automated glass doors are located in the South Access.

All reception counters, bars and self-service counters and the seating areas are accessible to wheelchair users.
