Seafood from Scotland, in collaboration with Scottish Development International, will return for the 30th instalment of Seafood Expo Global (SEG) in Barcelona from 23-25 April. Team Scotland will be showcasing 18 Scottish producers from various regions across Scotland, representing every step of the sea-to-plate journey, featuring a diverse array of fishers and processors.

The event will also be an opportunity for the Seafood from Scotland team to engage with buyers, media, and producers from across Europe ahead of the organisation co-hosting the Responsible Seafood Summit with Global Seafood Alliance, taking place in St Andrews, Scotland in October this year.
