At #IHSNY23, attendees, exhibitors and everyone in-between helped define the future of integrative healthcare—and we can't wait to do it again in 2024!














KEYNOTE

Kicking off Day Two of the Symposium, The 2023 Keynote Address was presented by Mark Hyman, MD with his session **Young Forever: The Emerging Science of Longevity**. Here's an overview of Dr. Hyman's address:

Getting older is inevitable but aging is optional. Emerging longevity science holds the potential to avoid the diseases of aging – diabetes, heart disease, cancer and dementia, to extend both healthspan and lifespan. The hallmarks of aging underlie all age related diseases. Through the lens of the hallmarks of aging, network, system and functional medicine, a new diagnostic and clinical model provides a roadmap to address the root causes of aging and activate longevity pathways.

To address these impediments and deal with dysfunctional hallmarks of aging, Dr. Hyman presented a strategy to enhance longevity, which he summed up in five key points:

- Dramatically reduce intake of sugar, starch, and processed foods
- Consume at least 30 to 40 grams of protein for breakfast, followed by another 16 grams between lunch and dinner
- **3** Increase phytonutrient intake
- 4 Incorporate resistance training
- **5** Find a community

AWARD HIGHLIGHT

The Integrative Healthcare Symposium awarded Peter D'Adamo, ND as the recipient of the 2023 Leadership Award! The Leadership Award recognizes a pioneer whose contributions have shaped integrative healthcare and paved the way for other practitioners and professionals. The award was presented by David Brady, ND, DC, CCN, DACBN, IFMCP, FACN and Woodson Merrell, MD. Dr. D'Adamo was accompanied by his wife and two daughters.

"It's just an honor to be here. I've looked at my career as an exercise in self-improvement," said D'Adamo. "But also, there was this belief that there was something deep down inside that could be part of a new reality."

D'Adamo is a second-generation naturopathic physician, researcher, software engineer, and author. He received his ND degree in 1982 as part of the inaugural graduating class at Bastyr University. From 2010 to 2019, D'Adamo was the Distinguished Professor of Clinical Sciences at the University of Bridgeport, where he, with his wife Martha, created the Center of Excellence in Generative Medicine, pioneering the application of precision bioinformatics in direct, real-time, patient care. He has created and coded Opus23, considered by many to be the premier clinical genomics integration and prescription tool. Over his three-decade teaching career, he has personally mentored hundreds of naturopathic medical students.

Peter D'Adamo played an active role in the three-day conference program, presenting: To Whisper Sweet Nothings: My Journey from Sugars to Glycomics.



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
